Re: New Covid Case

Dear Winfield Family,

I'm sending this letter to alert you that multiple members of our school community have tested positive for Covid-19. Based on available information, all parties who were considered close contacts have been alerted.

For clarity, the only item that has changed from our safe reopening plan is that masks have moved from "mandatory" to "strongly recommended". However, in an effort to adhere to the CDC Covid-19 Quarantine and Isolation guidance, we have adjusted our exclusion list.

- **Isolation:** If you test positive for Covid-19: stay home and ISOLATE from others for 5 days, End isolation after 5 full days if you are fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication) and your symptoms are improving, take precautions until day 10 (wear a well-fitting mask for 10 days anytime you are around others in your home or in public)
- **Quarantine:** If you ARE NOT up to date on vaccinations: Quarantine for 5 days, wear a well-fitting mask around people in your home, watch for symptoms, days 6-10: if you return to work or school following a negative test, wear a well-fitting mask around others, if you elect to not take a test, you may return to school after day 10.
- **Quarantine:** If you ARE up to date on vaccinations: NO Quarantine needed, just watch for symptoms, take precautions as needed.

In order to be considered fully vaccinated, all students over the age of 5 are to be vaccinated, and everyone over the age of 12 is to have received the Covid booster. As should always be the case, continue to monitor your children, and alert your healthcare provider if they report feeling ill. Should you have questions, please contact the main office.
