Tuesday, September 6 is the first day of school. Please ensure your annual school documents are filled in and returned to the office. Please see the website (winfieldschool.org) for those mandatory forms. New this year is our COVID understanding form which will be filled out once at the beginning of the year and will replace our daily COVID forms.

Both Tuesday, September 6 and Wednesday, September 7 will be early dismissal days. As is the case with all early dismissals, students will be released from school at 12:53 PM, and lunch will not be served. Our students are welcome to bring a snack and drink.

Some notes:

- When COVID cases occur, we will still be contact tracing and moving impacted students to remote learning, remote instruction will occur in the hours after school.
- If students are fully vaccinated, according to the CDC, there is no close contact, so there would be no need to move to remote learning.
- In the event that there are multiple cases of COVID in classrooms, we will continue to work with the NJDOH to determine the best course of action.
- When a student or staff member tests positive for COVID, we will communicate with them and the NJDOH to put the best plan in place for their return to school.
- In terms of days students will be excluded: the minimum will be 5 days with a mandatory masking period on days 6-10, per the CDC website.
- Our middle school students (grades 5-8) will once again be using their lockers, and they will be moving from class to class throughout their day, whereas last year the teachers moved to them.
